- Co-ordinating a shopfront in the main street of Townsville, including developing a roster;
- Organising renewable energy events and stalls;
- Networking with other organisations and renewable energy advocates in Townsville.

Selection criteria:

- A commitment to building Australia's renewable energy future;
- Experience with social change campaigning and working with volunteers;
- A high degree of autonomy and initiative;
- Demonstrated organisational skills, effectiveness under pressure and capacity and willingness to work in a small interdependent team.

Desirable qualities:

- Familiarity with Nationbuilder online system.
