Essential:

- Experience in the development of tertiary education curriculum and/or experience in curriculum development for custom education courses in the areas of global health, public health or international development
- Well-developed administrative and management skills with an ability to multi-task, effectively prioritise workflow
- Strong interpersonal skills with an ability to work effectively in a team environment and with people from culturally diverse backgrounds
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills, and the ability to effectively resolve conflict
- Self-starter with the ability to think independently and work with relative autonomy
- Strong written and verbal skills with a focus on attention to detail
- Ability to work flexible hours during development and delivery of intensive custom education courses

Desirable:

- Experience preparing custom education proposals/bids for external funders
- Recognised training and qualifications in learning design and/or curriculum development
- Experience or tertiary education qualifications in the fields of public and global health, or global development
- Experience of lecturing or tutoring in online education
- Experience working in the university and/or not for profit environment

- Experience in developing and/or delivering custom education products for learners from ESL backgrounds or for participants based outside of Australia
