An Inclusion Worker works with our Project Officers.




You might work on a few different projects at SACID.

Things you will do in the job



You will help to co-design resources and workshops by:

- Sharing your experiences as a person with intellectual disability
- Giving advice about how people with intellectual disability like to get information
- Testing the resources and workshops



You will help to make Easy Read information.

You will help run workshops by:



- Learning about the workshop
- Setting up the workshop space
- Making workshop participants feel welcome
- Speaking in front of the workshop participants
- Running activities during the workshop
- Supporting workshop participants to be involved

You will help with other events like:



- Information sessions
- Expos
- Presentations
- Conferences

You might travel around South Australia and interstate for work.



SACID will pay for travel costs like your hotel, meals and flights.

What you must be able to do

Work Independently



- Follow Instructions.
- Tell your boss what you have been working on.

Speak Up



- Ask for help if you need it.
- Tell people your ideas.
- Ask questions.

Work with others



- Work well with lots of people.
- Work well with your team.
- Work with your boss to plan your work.
- Be respectful to others.

Work safely



- Follow our policies and procedures.
- Let your boss know if you see something unsafe while working.
- Participate in training about keeping safe at work.
- Get a DHS Clearance. This is a check to make sure you are safe to work with people with disability.




Transport
