Purpose of Position

This position will be responsible for the further development and implementation of the Heart Failure in Primary Care program which aims to enhance management and patient support for heart failure in primary care by focusing on building the capacity of GP practices and promoting best practice management and patient self-management support for heart failure. Initially reporting to the System Design and Portfolio Manager – Chronic and Complex Care, for the design component of the role, this position will be responsible for developing the detailed project plan and communications strategy for the successful implementation of this program. This will include working with other PHN's in Victoria and key expert stakeholders - such as Specialist Cardiac Services, Professional Associations (APNA RACGP) and Heart Foundation - to leverage resources, information and best practice approaches already available about heart failure.

When the project moves to an implementation phase, the position will work as part of the Program Delivery and Service Enhancement team, reporting through to the Program Manager, Chronic and Complex Care. At this time the position will then be responsible for delivery and implementation of the project plan within the community.
