Position Context and Overview

The Group Worker is responsible for organizing and facilitating therapeutic and recreational groups for children and parents who have experienced homelessness and/or family violence. The Group Work Program is part of the larger Children's Specialist Support Service, and the Group Worker reports to the Coordinator/s of this team. This role is an exciting opportunity to create positive environments for children, and provide them with opportunities for play and learning.

Key Responsibilities

- Organise and facilitate regular recreational and therapeutic groups for children and/ or their parents
- Develop groups where needed, pilot these groups, and embed them in practice
- Build and maintain partnerships with external organisations, and grow opportunities for cofacilitation
- Enhance children's physical, social and emotional development through recreational and therapeutic group work
- Empower parents to support their children in relation to their developmental, social and emotional needs
- Support the bond between parents and their children
- Link children and parents to the local community, and provide referrals to local support services as necessary
- Manage administrative processes underpinning service delivery, including financial administration, data management and reporting processes
- Participate in service review and development, with a view to enhancing the provision of effective and efficient group work
- Contribute to a positive culture within your team and the organization as a whole that reflects Launch Housing's mission, vision and values
- Communicate effectively and proactively in your team
- Actively participate in supervision and coaching
- Maintain relevant relationships and proactively build Launch Housing's brand and enhance client outcomes

Key Selection Criteria

- Tertiary qualifications in Social Work, Psychology, Early Childhood or a related discipline
- Experience in the social service sector, preferably working with children with complex needs
- Experience with and knowledge of issues affecting children and families experiencing homelessness and/ or family violence
- An understanding of the ages and stages of childhood development
- Demonstrated ability to implement a trauma informed approach when designing and facilitating group work programs
- Demonstrated ability to build positive relationships and communicate with people of diverse backgrounds and abilities
- Highly developed self-reflection and self-care skills
- Excellent organisational and administrative skills with demonstrated ability to manage competing demands and meet deadlines
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Hold a current Victorian driver's license
