The position consists of three days per week collecting a broad range of materials from our supplies across the greater Brisbane region. Required duties include organising the truck run, contacting suppliers, liaising with the Shop Floor and Sorting Coordinators, manually loading and unloading the truck. They will also be required to work an additional day in our warehouse one Saturday approximately every four weeks on a rotating roster in sorting or sales, as well as participate in other work of the cooperative.
