The role is responsible for implementing activities arising from agreements with energy companies and developers, delivering projects, and supporting strong stakeholder and community engagement.

This position will help ensure the priorities and aspirations of the Gunaikurnai people as outlined in GLaWAC's Energy Strategy are reflected in project outcomes.

Reporting to the Major Projects Senior Manager, the role will contribute to partnerships across Gippsland with a strong focus on community connection, cultural respect, and sustainable development.

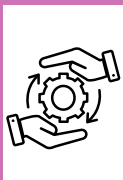
STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT
