We say **CID** for short.

In the job you will support people with intellectual disability in Tenterfield to



- Learn about rights



- Be **self advocates**.



Self advocates are people who speak up for their own rights.



This will be a **casual** job.

This means



- Some weeks you will work



- Some weeks there will be no work for you.



You will get paid **\$58.38** every hour you work.

Where you will work

You will work in

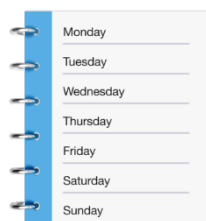


- The community in Tenterfield



- From your home.

What days



The days you work will change.



We will talk to you before we decide each time.

How long will the work happen in Tenterfield



CID has been given money by

Inclusion Australia to do this work.

This is called a **project**.



The project goes until **30 June 2027**.

What you will do in the job



The job is with CID.



CID supports people with intellectual disability to have good lives.

In the job you will



- Talk with people with intellectual disability about their rights



- Support them to learn to speak up



- Work with CID to plan a project that tells people about rights.



You will run groups and workshops with a CID staff member.



These will be in person and sometimes online.



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You will help make information for people with intellectual disability and services.



This could be things like Easy Read information or videos.



You will go to meetings to talk about the work CID is doing in Tenterfield.



You will be part of the CID Inclusion Services team.

What you must be able to do for this job

To do this job you must be able to



- Speak up about rights for people with intellectual disability



- Be able to talk to groups of people



- Support other people to speak up.

Some other things you need for the job are



- To be able to speak up if you need help



- Use a computer and email

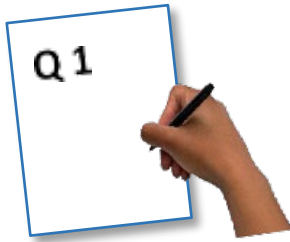


- Work by yourself sometimes

If you want to apply for this job answer the questions on the next pages.



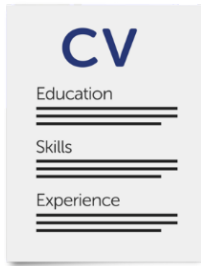
