We're building a National IT Team: a small, friendly group of volunteers who keep the Animal Justice Party's technology running smoothly and help it grow. You don't need to be an expert in every aspect of IT, or every system we use. You just need to care about animals and bring some tech know-how you're happy to share.

What the team will do

Work is shared across the team, so you can lean into the areas you enjoy most. Together, we'll:

- **Keep things running.** Look after the day-to-day operation of the Party's IT systems so staff and volunteers can focus on the cause.
- **Protect our people and data.** Keep our systems and member data secure and compliant, and run regular check-ups and audits.
- **Help our volunteers.** Give friendly, practical support and troubleshooting to volunteers and staff around the country.
- **Make things better.** Spot opportunities to improve our software and systems, and deliver projects that fit the Party's needs and budget.
- **Set good foundations.** Help shape simple, sensible IT policies and procedures.
- **Work with partners.** Liaise with external IT providers when needed.
- **Keep everyone in the loop.** Share regular updates with the Director of I.T.
